



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

Malaviya National Institute of Technology Jaipur

AND

National Institute of Industrial Engineering (NITIE), Mumbai

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING IS ENTERED INTO ON 08th June 2016 by and between, the Malaviya National Institute of Technology Jaipur, hereafter referred to as MNIT and the National Institute of Industrial Engineering, Vihar Lake, Powai, Mumbai, hereafter referred to as NITIE.

1. PREAMBLE

Malaviya National Institute of Technology, Jaipur is an Institute of national importance governed by the provisions of The National Institute of Technology Act 2007. The Institute is created as a center for imparting technical education of international standards and conducting research at the cutting edge of technology to meet the current and future challenges of technological development.

National Institute of Industrial Engineering (NITIE) was established by the Government of India in 1963 with the assistance of United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) through the International Labour Organization (ILO) to create skilled Industrial Engineering professionals.

MNIT and NITIE mutually appreciate and recognize the efforts for improving their quality of educational programmes. This memorandum of understanding is an outcome of the desires of both these institutions to enter into collaborative efforts towards enhancing quality teaching and research.

2. PURPOSE

The aim of this MoU is primarily to establish a document under which both the institutes may enter into a written agreement to perform collaborative programmes in the areas of mutual interest.

3. AREAS OF COLLABORATION

Both the Parties in principle agree to work in the following areas of collaboration:

- a) Faculty and student exchange towards research and teaching
- b) Partnering and supporting each other through joint research initiatives/projects,
- c) Offering joint courses/programs in areas of common interest
- d) Other academic/professional activities such as organizing conferences/seminars
- e) Any other activity decided and agreed by both parties

4. AGREEMENT OF COLLABORATIVE PROGRAMMES

This memorandum will be identified as the parent document of any program agreement executed between the parties. The scope of the activities under this memorandum will be determined jointly by both the institutions for the types of collaboration undertaken by faculty. Each such collaboration undertaken by the Institutes shall describe in details the following:


- a) The nature, scope and the time of collaborative schedule.
- b) Any other provision as deemed to be necessary and agreed by both.

5. COMMERCIALS

Both the Parties shall prepare and finalise the commercials with respect to each proposal under this MOU. In no case any financial or academic liability on one party would be transferrable on the other party.

6. NODAL AUTHORITY

The Nodal Officer from MNIT shall be the Director of MNIT or designated nominee and the Nodal Officer from NITIE shall be the Director of NITIE or designated nominee for all decisions making and concurrence.




7. IMPLEMENTATION AND ACTION PLAN

- i. NITIE and MNIT shall endeavor to finalise the details of implementation and action plan of collaborative efforts to execute the parts of this MoU from the academic year 2016- 2017.
- ii. Upon approval by each Party, this MoU shall be effective from the date of signing the same and shall remain in effect for the subsequent five years unless terminated earlier in writing by either institution. Notwithstanding the above, the period will, if necessary, be extended with consent in writing from the Parties.
- iii. Prof. Priyanka Verma from NITIE and Dean (Research & Consultancy) from MNIT shall co-ordinate for implementation of MOU.
- iv. Progress of MOU will be reviewed every year by Director MNIT and Director NITIE.


8. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

The two institutes shall meet through designated representatives and seek an equitable and fair understanding as to ownership and other property interests that may arise. Any such discussions will at all times strive to preserve a harmonious and continuing relationship between the parties.
