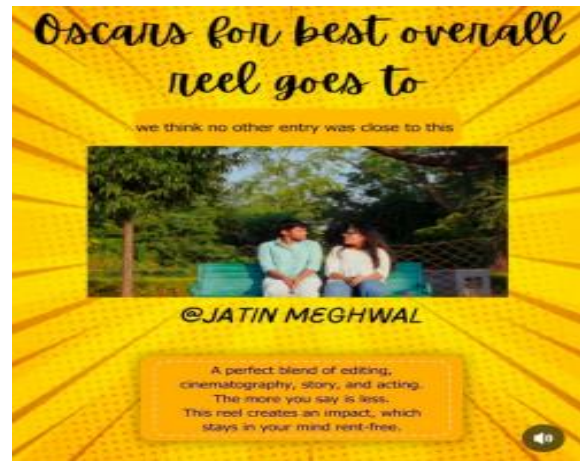
## 23. Self-Defense Awareness & Training Workshop (Think India) 19th November 2025

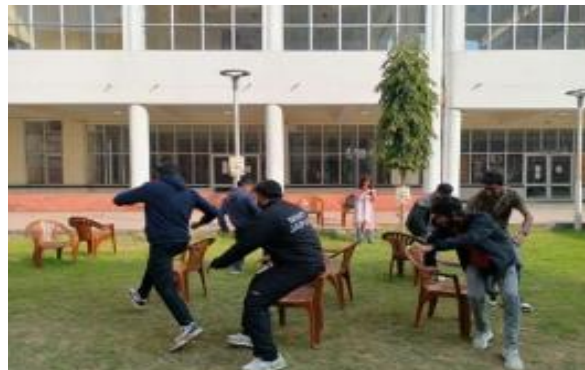
## 28.HollyBollyTolly (Film Making Club) 14<sup>th</sup> January 2026.

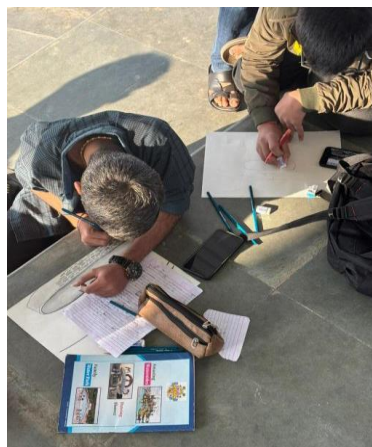
### 32.Aap Ki Sansad (Debate Club) 17<sup>th</sup> January 2026
