Malaviya National Institute of Technology Jaipur invites applications for one post of Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) Standardization Chair Professor from the regular faculty of the Institute.

Background and objectives

The creation of a BIS Standardization Chair is for research and development, teaching and training in the field of Standardisation and Conformity Assessment, in the country with focus on different fields of civil engineering, electrical engineering, mechanical engineering, chemical engineering, earthquake engineering, development and management of water resources and renewable energy projects, infrastructure development, medical biotechnology & nanotechnology, biomaterials, etc.

Roles and Activities of the BIS Standardization Chair Professor

The BIS Standardization Chair Professor is expected to provide leadership in one, or more, of the following areas:

- Coordinating R&D efforts towards development of standards and inputs to the drafts of new Indian Standards or revision/amendment of Indian Standards or that are of relevance to Conformity Assessment Schemes of the Bureau.
- Identifying and facilitating the integration of existing R&D project outputs with standards, as may be relevant.
- Undertaking review of Indian Standards involving thorough analysis of technical developments that have taken place in the product/processes/practices/use or application/testing/input materials, the international standards available, etc relevant to the standard under review.
- Preparation of handbooks/literature/case studies on implementation of Indian Standards and Conformity Assessment.
- Sensitizing and strengthening participation of the faculty/professors of MNIT in standards formulation activities of the Bureau.
- Promoting the integration of Indian Standards in course curricula of MNIT and for initiating short term course on standardization in MNIT.
- Organization of BIS-MNIT joint seminars, conferences, workshops, Symposia or lectures on topics of Standardization and Conformity Assessment of common interest

for dissemination of knowledge. At least one lecture to be given by the Chair Professor every year at an event organized by the Bureau.

- h) Designing and executing short-term capacity-building programmes and training programmes on Standardization and Conformity Assessment.
- i) Exchange with incubation centre in MNIT for promoting how standards can encourage/facilitate innovation.

Eligibility: Regular faculty members serving as Professor at MNIT Jaipur.

Age: Maximum 62 years

Tenure: - Initially for one (01) year, which may be extended for further two years on the basis of performance review on yearly basis.

Emoluments: Besides salary from the Institute, the Chair Professor will be paid an honorarium amount of Rs. 25,000/- per month. Additionally, contingency and travel support will be provided up to maximum of Rs. 1.00 Lac per year for the BIS related activities.

Application Procedure: Faculty members willing to apply for the above-mentioned position should fill up the form in the format available on the website <https://mnit.ac.in/>) along with necessary documents. Completed filled application form with all the testimonials should be sent through proper channel to Faculty Welfare office before the deadline.
